v5 And say unto them, Thus saith the Lord God;

In the day when I chose Israel, and lifted up mine hand unto the seed of the house of Jacob, and made myself known unto them in the land of Egypt, when I lifted up mine hand unto them,

saying, I am the Lord your God;

v8 But

they

rebelled against me:

they *did not* every man *cast away the abominations* of their eyes,

v10 Wherefore I caused them to go forth out of the land of Egypt, and brought them into the wilderness.

v11 And I

gave them my statutes,

and shewed them my judgments,

which if a man do, he shall even live in them.

v12 Moreover also I gave them my sabbaths,

to be a sign

between me and them,

that they might know

that I am the Lord that sanctify them.

v13 But

the house of Israel

rebelled against me in the wilderness:

they walked not in my statutes, and they despised my judgments,

which if a man do, he shall even live in them;

v18 But I said unto their children

*in the wilderness*, Walk ye not in the statutes of your fathers, neither observe their judgments, nor defile yourselves with their idols:

v19 I am the Lord your God;

walk in my statutes,

and keep my judgments,

and do them;

v20 And hallow my sabbaths;

and they shall be a sign

between me and you,

that ye may know

that I am the Lord your God.

v21 *Notwithstanding*

the children

rebelled against me:

they walked not in my statutes, neither kept my judgments to do them,

which if a man do, he shall even live in them;

*neither did they forsake the **idols** of Egypt:*

then I said,

I will pour out my fury upon them,

to accomplish my anger against them

*in the midst of the land of Egypt.*

v9 But I wrought

for my name's sake,

that it should not be polluted

before the heathen, among whom they were,

in whose sight I made myself known unto them, in *bringing* them forth out of the land of Egypt.

v6 In the day that I lifted up mine hand unto them,

to bring them forth of the land of Egypt

into a land that I had espied for them,

flowing with milk and honey, which is the glory of all lands:

and my sabbaths they greatly polluted:

then I said,

I would pour out my fury upon them in the wilderness,

to consume them.

[see phrase "in the wilderness" just above]

v14 But I wrought

for my name's sake,

that it should not be polluted

before the heathen,

in whose sight I brought them out.

v15 Yet also I lifted up my hand unto them

in the wilderness,

that I would *not* bring them

into the land which I had given them,

flowing with milk and honey, which is the glory of all lands;

v16 Because

they despised my judgments,

and walked not in my statutes,

they polluted my sabbaths:

then I said,

I would pour out my fury upon them,

to accomplish my anger against them

in the wilderness.

v22 Nevertheless I withdrew mine hand, and wrought

for my name's sake,

that it would not be polluted

in the sight of the heathen,

in whose sight I brought them forth.

v23 I lifted up mine hand unto them also

in the wilderness,

that I would scatter them

among the heathen,

and disperse them through the countries;

v24 Because

they had not executed my judgements,

but had despised my statutes,

but polluted my sabbaths:

for their heart went after their idols.

v17 *Nevertheless* mine eye spared them from destroying them, neither did I make an end of them in the wilderness.

v7 Then said I unto them,

Cast ye away every man

the *abominations* of his eyes,

and defile not yourselves

with the idols of Egypt:

I am the Lord your God.

v18 But I said unto their children in the wilderness,

Walk ye not

in the statutes of your fathers, neither observe their judgments,

nor defile yourselves

with their idols:

v19 I am the Lord your God;

- walk in my statutes,
- and keep my judgments, and do them;
- v20 And hallow my sabbaths;

and they shall be a sign between me and you,

that ye may know that I am the Lord your God.

and had polluted my sabbaths,

and their eyes were after their fathers' idols.

v25 *Wherefore*

I gave them also

statutes that were *not good*, and judgments whereby they should not live;

v26 And I *polluted them* in their own gifts,

in that they caused to pass through the fire all that openeth the womb,

that I might make them desolate, to the end

that they might know that I am the Lord.
